Now it's your turn to pick the design! You have been hired by a family to do either a bedroom (14'x16') or living room (16'x22'). Keeping the cost down is important to the family.

Step 1: Decide on a design style and color scheme

Step 2: Find samples of design elements for your room (At least 3 required)

- Furniture
- Floor coverings
- Rugs
- Wall treatments
- Window treatments
- Lighting
- Accent pieces
- Pictures

Step 3: Create a list of expenses for the items included (approximate costs are ok)

Step 4: Draw a floor plan

- Suggested furniture drawn in
- Accurate measurements
- Draw using ¼ inch scale

Step 5: Mount and label the samples, list of expenses, and floor plan on a poster board

Notes: Labels should be done in professional Lettering

On the bottom right corner of your poster board should be the **Title Block**
